During transition your child will be learning about alphabet letters and sounds, colours, numbers and families over the 5 week program.



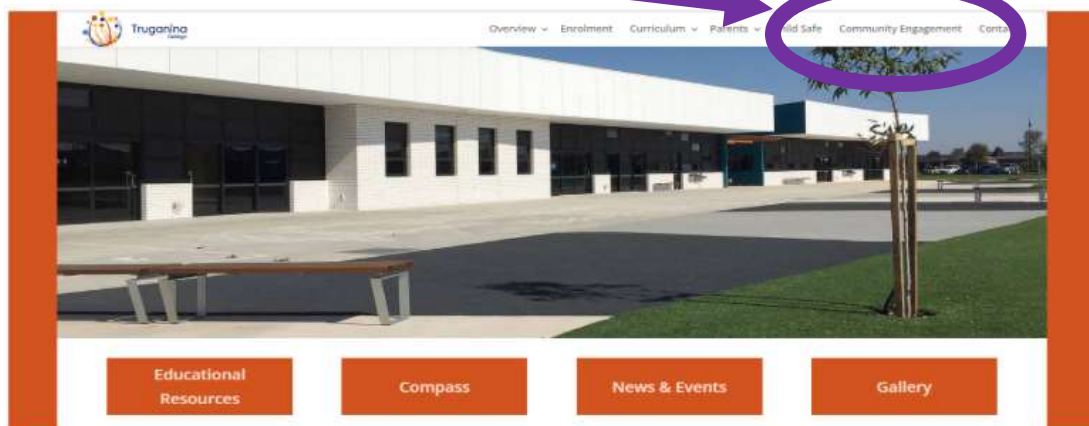
Community Engagement in Learning
