The members of the School Council met for the last time this year on 22 November 2021.

Mr. Christopher Pugh, our Acting Principal, presented correspondence from the Department of Education and Training (DET), which included information about the state wide roll-out of rapid antigen testing in schools, and their availability to families if they are required to be tested, at test sites.

The FISO (Framework for Improving Student Outcomes) Leaders presented information on the end of year monitoring of this year's Annual Implementation Plan.

Wyndham Council has accepted the school's request to install concrete pathways joining school paths to the council oval. The College is now seeking quotes to construct the concrete pathways to the Community Oval. School Council has also approved the renewal of the canteen contract for a further three years.
