Anaphylaxis is a severe, rapidly progressive allergic reaction that is potentially life threatening. Minimising risks protects vulnerable children and reduces opportunities for incidences. Anaphylaxis Action Plans are to be provided **ANNUALLY** and EpiPens/ Anapens are to be provided and in date. Forms are available from your GP.
