- 1. How did different groups experience life in the Australian colonies?
- 2. What aspects of life in colonial Australia have changed over time, and what has stayed the same? What were the causes and consequences of major events during this time period?
- 3. How can I use historical sources to understand the different perspectives of people at the time?
