



At School Supports

At Truganina P-9 College, we have the following supports in place for our Foundation students when they begin school:

- Designated play spaces for Foundation to Year 2 students
- Allowance for additional eating time
- Explicit teaching of school routines and expectations
- Social Emotional Learning (SEL) that teaches turn taking, co-operation and self regulation
- Pre-Foundation assessments to identify individual student needs (Literacy and Numeracy)

Students will wait with their teacher at their classroom. Once they see an adult, they let their teacher know and the teacher dismisses them.






Reports are released to families. It is a formal summary of student achievement and progress to date.



Term 3 Parent/Teacher Interviews (PTI)
